PROPOSITION K.I.D.S.

(If this proposition is approved, the adjusted operating levy of the District is estimated to increase by \$0.6000 from \$3.7580, currently, to \$4.3580 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation for Tax Year 2020 and can be applied to the assessed valuation for each year thereafter through Tax Year 2039.)
