Shall the Board of Education of the Drexel R-IV School District, Missouri, without an estimated increase in the current debt service property tax levy, borrow money in the amount of One Million Nine Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$1,950,000) for the purpose of providing funds to implement controls, recondition, and replace ductwork within the District's heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) systems; to install security access controls; to install new interior and exterior doors and locks; to add exterior lighting; to complete roof repairs, to resurface parking lots and playground; to the extent funds are available, complete other repairs and improvements to the existing facilities of the District; and issue general obligation bonds for the payment thereof? If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School District is estimated to remain unchanged at \$1.0672 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.
